1. Opening Prayer – Andrew Emanuel 'Welcome'

2. Adoption of Minutes of Previous Meeting – Moved by Amy Hague, Seconded by Andrea Deters

3. Matters arising from Previous minutes

4. Principals report - Michael Mifsud

- Catholic Schools week was a big success and enjoyed by many;
- Learning about learning was well attended;
- The open information session for new parents on the Wednesday was also well attended and the evening time proved popular;
- The cross country carnival went well, The younger children enjoyed the opportunity to participate;
- An auditor attended the school recently to conduct an equity audit to determine the equitable distribution of funds across the Diocese;
- Approximately 65 Principals from schools within the Diocese will be attending the school next week for the Principals association meeting;
- This year is the 25th Anniversary of Chisholm. Celebrations will be held on the 31st May this year. The Bishop along with our two Parish Priests will be celebrating an open air mass here at the school as well as other events;
- Each grade is having a planning day to enable forward planning of their learning.

5. PRC Meeting review -

Amy and Andrea attended the recent Parramatta Representative Council Annual General meeting and general meeting at St Patricks Blacktown. The meeting included a presentation titled "Dealing with Child anxiety" by Anoushka Houseman the wellbeing Co-ordinator for the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta. Consideration is being given to an evening workshop at school. Michael will liaise with Monique the school Counsellor.

6. Treasurers report

A treasurers report will be given at future meetings as required by the draft Constitution. New forms will be introduced for reimbursement.

A new form will be developed for pre-approval of spending funds by committee members. The school has a form that may be useful as a template.

7. School welcome disco -

10. Playground -

Our lady of Lourdes have just installed a traditional style playground and may be a useful source of information. The group discussed the idea of equipment that develops gross motor skills or is integrated with learning. Storytelling chairs, an outdoor stage and garden musical instruments were discussed. Further investigations is required.

11. Lunchtime Sporting equipment -

A roster is in place for use of the current sporting equipment available to the children for play with at lunch times. There is a roster for the use of footballs to ensure a safe number of balls are being used on the oval each day.

12. Athon -

The group discussed various ideas:

Colour run, Walk on the wild side – jungle\safari\animal, Walking on sunshine, Bee healthy and walk – insect, A walk down memory lane – characters from history, Walk like an Egyptian, Hollywood walk of fame, Walk on water – aquatic, Walk the plank – pirate. More investigation and discussion is required.

Gifts have been purchased and have arrived.
