## COVID - 19 Chisholm Update - 2 Stay Safe - Observe Social Distancing - Stay at Home

Dear Parents and Carers

As you would now be aware, Premier Berejiklian has confirmed that the NSW lockdown will be extended for one week. This means that for Week 1 Term 3, remote learning will be in place in our schools for the week.

I want to reassure families of children who need to be at school (children of essential workers, vulnerable students, or students who have no other supervision options) that onsite supervision will be available at school.

In line with State schools, all CEDP schools have been granted a pupil-free day on Day 1 of Term 3 Monday 12 July. This will be an opportunity for all schools to use the day to plan for remote learning for the week. Of course, supervision will be available on this pupil-free day for families who need this support.

We will be in contact with further information about arrangements for home learning as soon as possible. If your family needs to borrow a device or assistance with internet access, please contact the school office on Monday to discuss the support needed.

Pupil Free Day care (i.e. full day care) will be provided from our COSHC on Monday 12 July. Booking forms will be sent to COSHC families immediately to determine demand and are very happy to include other families. Enquiries can be sent to eyec.enrolments@cdpsl.org.au

Before and after school care will operate for the reminder of the week.
