We are pleased to announce that we will celebrate a Year 6 Farewell Mass. The Mass will be celebrated on our **Undercover Court** and Year 6 students are to **wear their full school summer uniform**. Arrival is from 6:10pm via the pedestrian entry near the front office. **Two adults and siblings per Year 6 student** are welcome to attend the Mass provided all participants strictly abide by the Public Health Orders, Catholic Schools NSW and Catholic Education, Diocese of Parramatta requirements below:

All visitors (16 years and over) to the school site must show evidence of full vaccination.

All staff, students and visitors

- are well and free from any flu-like symptoms, and have not been directed to self-isolate by NSW Health
- must wear a mask (exemptions must provide evidence prior) at all times during the Mass
- must sign in using the Chisholm QR code
- must sanitise on arrival and use good hand hygiene practices
- maintain physical distancing of 1.5 metres
- must remain seated as much as possible to minimise mingling between non-household members on the school site

Year 6 Dinner Dance - Friday 10 December at 6:00pm - 8:30pm

NSW Health currently permit the Chisholm Year 6 Dinner Dance to proceed provided the following guidelines are strictly adhered to:

- Only Chisholm Year 6 students and supervising staff are permitted to attend
- Parents & Carers must drop off and pick up their children at the front (bus bay) gate and maintain physical distancing of 1.5 metres at all times
- Year 6 students and staff
 - o must be well and free from any flu-like symptoms and have not been directed to self-isolate by NSW Health
 - o must sanitise on arrival and use good hand hygiene practices before and after eating, and during the event
 - o must maintain physical distancing of 1.5 metres in the MPA and Undercover Court
- The dance floor will be outside on the Undercover Court
- Singing and chanting during the event is not permitted
- Dancing is permitted, however physical distancing of 1.5m still applies
- Year 6 students must remain within the designated celebration area and leave promptly at the conclusion of the event

We ask for your understanding as there is a possibility that events may be cancelled at short notice due to Public Health Orders. Other arrangements may need to be made depending on the NSW Health advice of the day.

Please contact the grade teachers or Mrs Gatt if you have any questions. It is our wish that our Year 6 students are provided with a farewell from their Primary school they will remember.
