

Year Two Learning Overview

Term 4, 2022

Welcome to Term 4. We look forward to a great term of learning.



This term in Religious Education we are learning:

- how Mission is loving God and people as Jesus shows us
- the experiences of "waiting" in the Bible and recalling those who waited for the birth of Jesus
- the true meaning of Christmas and how it is a time of happiness when we celebrate the birth of Jesus.



We will continue our Literacy learning through the elements of our Literacy block, which are:

- Reading groups
- Shared reading
- Independent reading
- Read aloud

- Modelled writing
- Guided writing
- Independent writing

Our writing this term will focus on writing a range of informative, imaginative and persuasive texts.



This term we will explore mathematical concepts through open-ended investigations and rich tasks. We will be learning:

- Time
- Multiplication & Division
- Whole Numbers
- 2D Shapes and Area
- Addition & Subtraction
- 3D Objects and Volume
- Length and Fractions
- Statistics & Probability

We are working on becoming numerate learners who can use mathematical processes to investigate and explore mathematical problems. We encourage students to practise skills that promote the recall of number facts through number busting.

- 1 more / 1 less, 10 more / 10 less, 100 more / 100 less
- Doubles and Near doubles

- Partners of ten
- Skip Counting from any given number forwards and backwards



This term students will have the opportunity to learn about the observable changes that occur in the sky and on the land, and identify how seasonal changes in our daily lives affect living things. They will also be learning about the Earth's resources and how we use and care for them.

In Coding lessons with Mrs Lark, students will begin to use Google Classroom in preparation for their transition to Primary next year. They will learn skills that will assist them to access their own online folders and work. They will also continue developing their skills using the Sora eLibrary app.



In **MUSIC** lessons, students will listen to and discuss music from animated movies. They will also begin to develop notation reading skills by playing boomwhackers to both classical and modern music. There will also be some preparation for a Christmas concert at the end of the year.

This term in **DRAMA** we will be focusing on presenting the story of the Three Little Pigs to an audience. The students will have the choice of presenting the traditional version or the fractured fairy tale.

In VISUAL ARTS we will be completing a variety of Christmas crafts and art with a focus on the Nativity.



This term in **Personal Development and Health** we will be focussing on how we can be inclusive and respectful to others and how we are responsible for my own, and others' health, safety and wellbeing.

In **Physical Education** with Mrs Baxter this term the students will participate in two different sports Oztag/Touch Football and AFL. The aim is to introduce students to 2 - 3 different versions of football played in Australia. During the unit, students will learn the rules and skills applicable to their age so that they can play the game. They will also understand that while equipment in games may be similar it is the rules and skills involved that make the sports different.
