## Afternoon Dismissal Arrangements 2022 KISS & RIDE IS THE PREFERRED DISMISSAL PROCEDURE

In keeping with NSW Public Health Orders and Catholic Education, Diocese of Parramatta guidelines, our preferred afternoon dismissal procedure is via **KISS and RIDE**. Our afternoon dismissal procedures are at **set**, **staggered times** in **grade groups** to minimise the mixing of students across cohorts. We have taken into consideration family groups and siblings being able to leave at the same time.

Your allocated family sign MUST be clearly displayed on the passenger visor of your car. The family signs will enable us to ensure all students from specific grades and families are at the Kiss and Ride bay ready to be safely collected at each designated time.

Time to arrive at Kiss and Ride	Year Groups + Siblings
2.40pm	Year 1 and 2 and siblings
2.55pm	Kindergarten and siblings
3.05pm	Years 3 and 4 and siblings
3.15pm	Year 5 and 6 and siblings
Any students who are picked up by parents and carers can be collected from the pick up area in the staff car park from 2:45pm.	

To work together as a safe, honest and respectful learning community, please follow these simple steps:

- Arrive at your child/ren's allocated afternoon dismissal time.
- Display your family sign clearly on your passenger visor.
- Remain within your vehicle at all times.



 If you arrive earlier than your child/ren's designated time, please continue to drive on and not line up in the Kiss and Ride bay as your child/ren will not be ready to be collected. Your cooperation will ensure the safety of all students, minimise congestion and adhere to NSW road rules. Police and Council's Compliance staff will

minimise congestion and adhere to NSW road rules. Police and Council's Compliance staff will be monitoring schools and when driving or parking infringements are observed, fines may be issued.

- If you are unable to use Kiss and Ride, you are welcome to pick up your child/ren from the Kiss and Ride gate from 2:45pm. It is essential that the Kiss and Ride area in front of the school remains clear, especially from 2:40-3:15pm. Parents and carers are to wait in front of the staff car park gates. Parents and carers are asked not to congregate near the Kiss and Ride area to ensure the safety of all our students.
- If you have an appointment or need to pick up your child/ren earlier than your designated time, please contact the office to arrange an early pick up.

Please note: Children who walk home or ride a bike will be dismissed at 3:00pm. Students who catch a bus will be supervised at the bus bay.
