Dance Fever - Gymnastics

In Term 3, all Chisholm students will participate in Dance Fever, an external school provider for gymnastics and fundamental movement lessons. The Dance Fever Gymnastics program will be covered by our school excursion fee. Gymnastics instructors from Dance Fever will visit Chisholm each Friday starting from Week One next term.

Dance Fever Gymnastics meets school curriculum compliance. Dance Fever staff hold coaching qualifications with Gymnastics AUS, providing them with specialised skills to make gymnastics enjoyable, skilful and safe. Dance Fever instructors will teach the students a variety of skills that involve strength, balance, and coordination. The program will also teach the students social skills such as self expression, respect for others, etiquette, school spirit, teamwork and sportsmanship through exercise and enjoyment.
