Walk Safely to School Day - Friday 20 May

National Walk Safely to School Day (WSTSD) is on **Friday 20 May 2022**. We encourage parents and carers to walk to school with primary school age children or if you must use the car, try leaving it a good distance from the school and walk the rest of the way. This is an opportunity for parents and carers to help their child/children to develop vital road crossing skills and promote road safety, health, public transport and the environment. Children up to the age of 10 years are encouraged to hold an adult's hand when crossing the road.

Any students who are picked up by parents and carers can be collected from the pick up area in the staff car park from 2.55pm.

To work together as a safe, honest and respectful learning community, please follow these simple steps:

- Arrive at your child/ren's allocated afternoon dismissal time.
- Display your family sign clearly on your passenger visor.
- Remain within your vehicle at all times.
- If you arrive earlier than your child/ren's designated time, please continue to drive on and not line up in the Kiss and Ride bay as your child/ren will not be ready to be collected. Your cooperation will ensure the safety of all students, minimise congestion and adhere to NSW road rules. Police and Council's Compliance staff will be monitoring schools and when driving or parking infringements are observed, fines may be issued.
- If you have an appointment or need to pick up your child/ren earlier than your designated time, please contact the office to arrange an early pick up.

Please note: Children who walk home or ride a bike will be dismissed at 3:00pm. Students who catch a bus will be supervised at the bus bay.
