Please arrange for your order to be collected from the learning space closest to the Bus Bay area and enter via the Bus Bay gate, not the school office or staff car park gate. A school leader will be present to direct you to the collection point. Please do not park in our Kiss and Ride Zone between 2:30 and 3:30pm. If your child attends Ambrose on Monday afternoon and your order is not collected by 4:00pm, we will deliver the orders to Ambrose to be collected by an adult when you pick up your child/ren. We thank the CCG and the volunteers who have organised and prepared your orders. Thank you for your cooperation and support. We hope you enjoy making your tasty cookies.

### **Summer Uniform**

### **Attendance**

Attendance is marked each day in the Class Attendance Register which is a legal document. Children arriving after the morning 8.45am bell must go through the office for a late pass before proceeding to their learning spaces. Parents & Carers are required to sign a child in if they are late. All absences, including late arrival and early departures are recorded in the class roll and on Student Reports. An explanation for a child's absence must be recorded through the Compass portal or by notifying the school office or child's teacher.
