

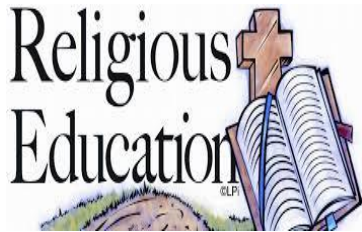

Year One Learning Overview

Term 2 - 2022

Welcome to Term 2. We look forward to a great term of learning.



This term we have two units for Religious Education.

In the first unit, **Easter Season - Together**, students will be learning the importance of the resurrection and how Jesus is risen and with us today. The second unit, **Stories of Jesus**, focusses on the importance of the Bible as it holds the stories of and about Jesus. Students will identify the ways they love and help others like Jesus has taught them.



We will continue our Literacy learning through the elements of our Literacy block, which are:

- Reading groups
- Shared reading
- Independent reading
- Read aloud
- Modelled writing
- Guided writing
- Independent writing

This term in writing we will focus on writing imaginative stories, giving our opinion in persuasive texts and exploring how to give information by writing information reports.

We will read a variety of texts throughout the term. We will be encouraging all students to read a variety of books both at home and at school.



This term we will continue exploring mathematical concepts through open-ended investigations and rich tasks.

Some of the topics we will be learning are:

- Whole Numbers - Place Value
- Multiplication and Division
- Addition and Subtraction
- Geometric Measure - fractions & decimals
- Non-spatial measure - Time & Mass
- Three dimensional objects

We encourage students to practise skills which promote the recall of number facts.

- 1 more / 1 less, 10 more / 10 less, 100 more / 100 less
- Doubles
- Partners of ten
- Near doubles
- Skip counting by 2s, 5s and 10s



This term in Science and Technology we are exploring the topic '*Living Things*'. We will be learning what living things need to survive, their features and how we can take care of them. Our excursion to Sydney Zoo will help us start our unit with hands-on experience.

In Coding with Mrs Lark, students will continue using the BlueBot robots. They will create their own codes, follow pre-written codes and the codes of their peers, and continue to work productively with a partner and in small groups.



CREATIVE ARTS

VISUAL ARTS will focus on students making artworks representing both real and imagined situations exploring a range of techniques and media. They will discuss qualities of artworks such as subject matter and technique, recognising that artists create artworks for different audiences. This unit also aims to introduce famous Australian artists and their techniques to the students.

In **DANCE**, students perform dances with some understanding of body movement and expression, exploring a range of movements to make choices in order to convey ideas, feelings and moods. They describe the ideas, feelings and moods conveyed by dances.

The **MUSIC** unit this term is from Other Cultures: Torres Strait Islands. Students will listen to Torres Strait Islander music and have the opportunity to sing and dance various songs from this culture. Students will also continue gaining skills in rhythm and beat by playing non-tuned percussion instruments.



This term our Personal Development and Health unit is *Health, Wellbeing and Relationships*. Students will describe their own and others' strengths and achievements and identify how these contribute to personal identity. They will describe and practise ways to develop caring and respectful relationships and include others to make them feel they belong.

Students in Year 1 will participate in two different sports this term Oztag/Touch Football and AFL. Students will be introduced to different versions of football played in Australia. During the unit they will learn the rules and skills applicable to their age so that they can play the game and understand that while equipment in games may be similar it is the rules and skills involved that make the sports different.
