

# Year One Learning Overview

# Term 4, 2022

## Welcome to Term 4. We look forward to a great term of learning.



This term in Religious Education there are three units, Sharing With Others, Advent and Christmas. Sharing With Others will focus on Jesus' sharing and caring for others and how we can do the same. The Advent unit will teach students that at this time of year we are waiting and preparing for the birth of Jesus, as individuals and as a family. The last unit focuses on the scripture of the birth of Jesus and the role of the Three Wisemen.



We will continue our Literacy learning through the elements of our Literacy block, which are:

- Reading groups
- Shared reading
- Independent reading
- Read aloud

- Modelled writing
- Guided writing
- Independent writing

Our writing this term will focus on writing the elements necessary to produce persuasive, informative and imaginative texts. We will read a variety of texts throughout the term. We will be encouraging all students to read a variety of books both at home and at school.



This term we will continue exploring mathematical concepts through open-ended investigations and rich tasks.

Some of the topics we will be learning are:

- Whole Numbers Place Value
- Multiplication and Division
- Addition and Subtraction
- Geometric Measure Fractions & Decimals
- Non-spatial measure Time and Mass
- Three-Dimensional objects

We encourage students to practise skills which promote the recall of number facts.

- 1 more / 1 less, 10 more / 10 less, 100 more / 100 less
- Partners of ten
- Doubles
- Near doubles
- Skip counting by 2s, 5s and 10s



The aim of our HSIE unit is to stimulate students' interest in and enjoyment of exploring the past. We will look into how family life has changed or stayed the same and how we can show that the present is similar or different to the past.



In Coding lessons with Mrs Lark, students will sequence pictures that show the events of the Nativity. They will then write a program for a BlueBot robot to follow the sequence of the Nativity in the correct order. They will try a range of options and test their favourite track. They will also test and follow the codes of their peers.



#### CREATIVE ARTS

VISUAL ARTS will focus on students making artworks representing both real and imagined situations exploring a range of techniques and media. Students will discuss qualities of artworks such as subject matter and technique, recognising that artists create artworks for different audiences.

In **MUSIC** lessons, students will listen to music from ballet stories. They will have the opportunity to play non-tuned percussion instruments to develop their aural skills. There will also be some preparation for a Christmas concert at the end of the year.



In **Physical Development and Health**, students will learn about and practise strategies they can use to support their own and others' health, safety and wellbeing.

In **Physical Education** with Mrs Baxter this term, students will participate in two different sports, Oztag/Touch Football and AFL. The aim is to introduce students to 2 - 3 different versions of football played in Australia. During the unit they will

learn the rules and skills applicable to their age so that they can play the game. Students will also understand that while equipment in games may be similar, it is the rules and skills involved that make the sports different.
