

# Year 4 Learning Overview

Term 2 - 2022

# Welcome to Term 2. We look forward to a great term of learning.



The Units we will be learning this term are:

Easter Season: New Life - Students will analyse the Resurrection of Jesus and how this bible passage is represented through the different Gospels. They will further develop their understanding of life and death and how the disciples of Jesus experienced life after his Resurrection.

**Eucharist:** Structure of the Mass - Students will explore the key elements, sequencing and the significance of the celebration of the Eucharist. Students will develop an understanding of the Eucharist as a way in which to express their own faith.



We will continue our Literacy learning through the elements of our Literacy block, which are:

- Reading groups
- Shared reading
- Independent reading
- Read aloud

- Modelled writing
- Guided writing
- Independent writing

Our writing this term will focus on creating imaginative, informative and persuasive texts with specific reference to structure, sophisticated language, audience and conventions of writing (spelling, punctuation and grammar). We will read a variety of texts throughout the term that relate to children living in different moments in time. All students are encouraged to read a variety of texts both at home and school.



This term we will explore mathematical concepts through open-ended investigations and rich tasks. Students will be extended and supported through extension tasks as well as masterclasses. We will be learning:

- Angles
- Fractions & Decimals
- Area

- Addition & Subtraction
- Multiplication & Division
- Time

- Position
- Mass
- Patterns & Algebra

We are working on becoming numerate learners who can use mathematical processes to investigate and explore mathematical problems. We encourage students to practise skills which promote the recall of number facts and times tables including:

- 1 more / 1 less, 10 more / 10 less, 100 more / 100 less
- Doubles and Near doubles
- Skip counting from any given number
- Use their multiplication facts to answer a variety of questions



### **HISTORY**

This term Year 4 students will be focusing on an inquiry into how *The Stories* and *Voices of the First Fleet*. Students will describe people, events and actions related to world exploration and its effects. They will describe and explain the effects of British colonisation in Australia, and apply skills of historical inquiry and communication.



### SCIENCE and TECHNOLOGY

This term students in Year 4 will be focusing on Project-Based Learning. PBL is a dynamic learning approach in which students actively explore real-world problems and challenges, and acquire a deeper knowledge. This term we will be exploring the question: How can we as scientists explain to Year 5 how heat, light and electrical energy make things happen?

In **Coding** with Mrs Lark, Year 4 will use coding websites to solve specific coding problems, examine their codes in JavaScript, and create their own codes. They will continue to develop their problem-solving skills and gain a clearer understanding of what makes a successful code.



## CREATIVE ARTS

Music will continue to focus on developing skills in notation and performance by playing the recorder. The unit this term is about Painters and Composers. This gives students an opportunity to evaluate music and painting from a personal perspective. For example, they will explore Van Gogh's "Starry Night" and listen to Beethoven's "Moonlight Sonata" to see if one reflects the other.

**Drama** will focus on developing a variety of skills and strategies within the artform. Students will explore improvisation, miming, puppetry and vocal skills. In drama the students will also be practising taking on the role of a character from a different time.

Dance this term will allow them to create and perform a movement sequence to a song from a musical. To enhance their understanding they will be appreciating and viewing a range of dances from a variety of different musicals that have been created over time.



# PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT, HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

This term our Personal Development and Health unit is about Protective Behaviours. This unit of work will aid the students in:

- Recognising and responding to unsafe situations
- Seeking assistance effectively
- Establishing and maintaining positive relationships
- Strengthening attitudes and values related to equality, respect and responsibility

In **Sport**, students will take part in the trials for the Athletics Carnival to be held at the end of the term. All students in Year 4 will trial for discus, shot put, long jump and 800m. They will be given the opportunity to watch themselves perform discus and shot put in order to give themselves the opportunity to improve their throwing techniques. Students will also be introduced to improving their distances by using whole body movements in discus and shot put.
