

Year 5 Learning Overview

Term 4, 2022

Welcome to Term 4. We look forward to a great term of learning.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This term Year 5 will be exploring how the Church is being led by the Holy Spirit, honours Mary and how we can live a life following Catholic mission. Students will also be preparing for Advent, including developing an understanding of God's call to Mary. We will learn how Mary freely responds in faith and trusts God's invitation, and in doing so prepared the way for the gift of Jesus.



ENGLISH

We will continue our Literacy learning through the elements of our Literacy block, which are:

- Reading groups
- Shared reading
- Independent reading
- Read aloud

- Modelled writing
- Guided writing
- Independent writing

Our writing this term will focus on informative newspaper articles and historical narratives based on research about migrant groups from the colonial era.



MATHEMATICS

This term we will continue exploring mathematical concepts through open-ended investigations and rich tasks. We are working on becoming numerate learners who can use mathematical processes to investigate and explore mathematical problems. We will be learning:

We encourage students to practise skills and develop strategies in relation to their Mathematics learning goals. Students are able to locate these specific activities on Google Classroom and are aware of the task they should be working on for each domain.



HISTORY

This term students will study Colonial Australia in the 1800s focusing on the perspectives and stories of migrant Australians. They will learn about what life was like for different groups in the Colonial period. They will examine

significant events and people, political and economic developments, social structures and settlement patterns during Australian colonisation and the lasting impacts these groups brought to Australian society.



SCIENCE

In Coding lessons with Mrs Lark, students will return to the Ozoblockly website to create a series of codes they will upload to an Ozobot to test, evaluate and modify, in order to complete some complex projects, including 10 pin bowling and synchronised dancing.



CREATIVE ARTS

In **Drama**, students will adapt short stories to create and perform a new work with clear intent, applying what they have learnt about the elements of drama through composing, performing and appreciating.

In Visual Arts, students will develop their knowledge, skills and understanding in making artworks informed by their investigations of the world as subject matter, use of expressive forms and consideration of the audience for their works. They will develop their knowledge, skills and understanding in appreciating their own artworks and those of others, recognising some relationships between artists, artworks, audiences and how the world is interpreted.

In **Music** lessons with Mrs Hancock, students will continue to work on their composition, implementing the skills and strategies covered in Term 3. The listening music will be Jazz music from a variety of modern composers. There will also be some preparation for a Christmas concert at the end of the year.



PDHPE

This term, students will investigate how responsible they are for their own and others' health, safety and wellbeing. In addition, they will examine the role of physical activity in promoting health and wellbeing. Students will also examine how what they eat affects their health and how to make educated choices in what they consume. They

will explore how the media and people in the community influence their choices and examine how a healthy, safe and active lifestyle enhances connections with others.

Physical Education

Students will refresh their skills and knowledge of the rules for Cricket, Netball and AFL. This unit is about refining skills, applying their understanding of games and sports through skill development, playing the game and officiating.
